Dear Parish Family,

It felt like I had a very bad flu, but thankfully towards the end of the week I started to feel better.

I had a few people ask me if I was in the hospital because they heard it from others. That is not at all the case. I was not in the hospital, I stayed at home. That's why we shouldn't allow idle chat to take up our lives. I am grateful to those who prayed for me, and for all of you for helping out the priests who last agreed to fill masses extremely last minute.

I have some great news! It is with great joy that I announce our *Accendo* (pronounced ah-chen-doe), which is a Latin word that means "to cause to burn" or "to kindle a flame." In the Gospel of Luke, Christ mentions, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" Elsewhere in Scripture, Christ compares our faith to a burning lamp that should not be hidden under a basket but allowed to shine brightly for all to see.
