This weekend will be John's last weekend with us. Please read his goodbye letter in the bulletin and be sure to wish him well after mass. After our 11 a.m. mass, we will have a small going away celebration in the entry way and canopy for John. There will be cake, and some light refreshments. Please feel free to come after mass as we wish him well before he goes back to his seminary studies.

As I mentioned last weekend, we will be starting our parish youth group, *Accendo*, which comes from the Latin word meaning "light" or "kindle." The goal is to kindle in our young people the fire of the faith, so that they may be, as Christ tells us all, a light to the world. We will have our first meeting on Sunday, August 25th. It will consist of food, fun, and adoration. It will be for our 9th Graders to 12th Graders. I remember going to the youth group at my home parish and have fond memories, so be sure to tell your kids and grandkids that they are invited!

On August 4th, after the 11 a.m. mass, I will do a Blessing of Backpacks for the start of the school year. This blessing will also be given to all our teachers and students as we quickly approach the start of another year! This weekend, we begin the Bread of Life Discourse, which we will hear for about four weeks. The Bread of Life Discourse is directly linked to the Eucharist, and the Last Supper. It is a beautiful discourse on the Eucharist, and over the next few weeks I would strongly encourage everyone to faithfully read and reread Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel. It contains so many truths that cannot be expounded upon in a short homily at mass.

Finally, if anyone is interested in learning more about the Catholic faith and/or converting to Catholicism. We will be starting our Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, also called O.C.I.A. soon.
