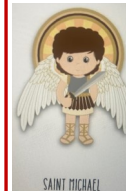

This weekend the Church celebrates Trinity Sunday! The Trinity is a central doctrine of our faith. We believe that in the unity of the Godhead there are Three Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, these Three Persons being truly distinct one from another. The Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet we do not worship three gods but one God.
