We also welcome the lota High graduates at our 11 a.m. mass. We would like to keep them and all our graduates in our prayers as they experience an important milestone in their lives. Speaking of graduates, this upcoming Wednesday, May 8th we will have an Alumni Mass with St. Francis School. So, we invite our alumni to attend this mass. Please come out and help spread the word!

Also, we will be implementing a new ministry in our parish. Christ challenges us, "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink..." We will be starting a new ministry called *From Mary's Kitchen*, which will serve as a meal train for those in need. I am grateful to Amanda Stewart for spearheading this ministry. Meals are provided on a temporary basis to St. Joseph and St. Michael parishioners experiencing the birth of a child, miscarriage, illness, the death of a family member, hard times or any situation where a delivered meal might provide relief. Meals are typically delivered three to five times a week for one to two weeks around supper.

Please let us know if you or someone you know could benefit from a meal train. If you would like a meal please contact the office, give them your information, and they will pass it along to Amanda who will set up the meal train for you. If you would like to sign up to make meals, we will have a sign-up sheet in both churches. Secondly, please read the letter from Tonia regarding her future role in the choir, I am grateful to her for serving the choir for so many years. Sacred music is extremely important in our Church and isn't something that should be taken lightly. Finally, we will be getting a summer seminarian! We will welcome John Michael Fruge, Jr. to our parish on June 1st and his assignment will end on July 31st. He also has written a brief letter to introduce himself to the parish!
